CRICKET CLOTHING All juniors are expected to wear club cricket shirt and whites for games, including predominantly white footwear, and to wear white tops for training. The only equipment we encourage boys and girls to buy is their own box.

Wokingham Cricket Club will not allow any young player to bat, or stand up to the stumps when keeping wicket against a hard ball without wearing a helmet. Wokingham Cricket Club include helmets in the Club equipment for use as required.

Video Analysis, the coach may use the video to show the participants their batting and bowling techniques. NOTE: All ECB qualified coaches at Level 2 & above are legally allowed to video children with Parent or Carer Consent.

All of our coaches and managers attend First Aid and Child Protection courses and all will be CRB checked.
