## **The Members Charter**

The Members Charter has been prepared to set out the expectations of members of Wokingham Cricket Club.

### **1) Responsibilities of a Wokingham Cricket Club Member**

At the AGM each year a small Executive Committee is appointed by the membership to undertake the formal duties of the club.

However, the running of a cricket facility such as we have at Wokingham is an enormous task and it is the responsibility of all club members to share in the work load.

Members are expected to treat the facilities and grounds as they would their own and to volunteer their services for whatever activities are required for the current and future well being of the club.

All club members are to follow the behaviours set out in the Players Code of Conduct.

### **2) Wokingham Players Code of Conduct**

At Wokingham, we will follow the ECB Code of Conduct and Spirit of Cricket Regulations covering players' code of conduct both on and off the field.

Specifically, any Wokingham CC player or official;

- Will conduct themselves fairly and properly – on and off the field of play.
- Will NOT use language that is offensive or insulting toward a player, umpire, team official or spectator.
- Will NOT dispute decisions nor react provocatively towards Umpires at any time.
- Will NOT engage in excessive and/or intimidatory appealing
- Will respect and welcome all players and guests to Wokingham Cricket Club.
